The Need

The Berean Bible Society believes that one of the most critical needs for grace believers today is biblically sound Sunday school lessons; that is why this ministry exists.

What is Growing Up In Grace?

Growing Up In Grace (GUIG) is a Bible teaching ministry designed to instruct and encourage young people. The goal is to provide lessons that can confidently be used to proclaim the Gospel of the Grace of God to all students.

Intentions of this Ministry

The GUIG lessons are designed to be Grace-based, biblically sound, and salvation oriented. In addition, personal spiritual growth is strongly emphasized. The lessons are intended to foster a deep love and respect for the Lord and the Grace message that will continue throughout a student's life.

Bible Lessons Designed For:

Sunday school, church, home schools, youth groups, Bible studies, youth camps, personal reading, missionary work, family devotions, etc.

Lesson Contents

Junior Lessons: The format for these lessons is a three-ring binder. Each lesson contains a complete teachers manual (teacher's guide, graphics, games, object lessons, review, Bible lesson, story, take home sheet, etc.). Each quarter is a compilation of 13 lessons. The purchaser has permission to make copies of the take home sheets. So, with one purchase "you're good to go," year after year, teaching as many young people as the Lord directs your way.

At the conclusion of each lesson there is an application to assure the teachings are made relevant to daily life, a Gospel presentation so the unsaved know the plan of salvation, and an encouragement section to build-up and help the saved student who is trying to live for the Lord.

Middle School Lessons: The format for these lessons is a spiral-bound book. These lessons include developing a stronger relationship with Christ, addressing concerns of middle school students, encouraging devotional time and personal prayer life, and connecting Bible teaching with daily life. All this is put together with humor, class discussions, and activities that meet the students' needs in a biblical manner.

Lessons Available

Junior Level — Ages 9-11 (grades 4-6)

Year One: An overall view of the major **events** of the Bible, creating a simple time-line.

Quarter One: *Creation—Exodus*

Quarter Two: *Wilderness—Stephen*

Quarter Three: *Saul—Christ's Reign*

Year Two: Focuses on the main **characters** of the Bible.

Quarter One: *Character of God—Joseph*

Quarter Two: *Moses—Esther*

Quarter Three: *Herod—John*

Year Three: Explores the major **biblical doctrines** that apply to a student's life today. Care is taken to make sure that God's Word for the Age of Grace is made clear and not confused with instructions for other ages.

Quarter One: *The Trinity—Standing & State*

Quarter Two: *New Creation—Obedience*

Quarter Three: *Peace—Heavenly Promises*

Independent Quarter: Focuses on **The Life of Our Lord Jesus Christ** from a true grace perspective. This quarter can be taught during the summer or individual lessons can be taught on holidays or special events or VBS.

The individual years are designed so they can be taught in any order. Lessons are easily adaptable to older students.

Middle School — Ages 12-14 (grades 7-9)

Year One: The overall theme for year one is "The Grace Life." Each book consists of thirteen lessons that contain a teacher's outline, a lesson written to the teacher, discussion questions, and reproducible student pages.

Book One: Christ in My Heart. Chapter titles include: "Grace in My Daily Life", "The Will of God in My Life", "Helping Those Who Are Hurting", etc.

Book Two: Christ in My Life. Chapter titles include: "Developing Godly Character and Values", "Witnessing to Others", "Christ-honoring Relationships", etc.

Book Three: Christ in My World. Chapter titles include: "Bible and Archaeology", "Bible and Science", "Grace Doctrine Review", "Things to Come", etc.

Grace-Based Lessons

The GUIG lessons promote salvation and growth in the Lord Jesus Christ. However, the lessons are careful to teach and apply all Scripture in light of the Mystery revealed to the Apostle Paul. The lessons present a dispensational approach to Bible study, teaching the Word rightly divided. The lessons do not mix or confuse Law and Grace.
