Hold the paper up to a window or bright light and trace on to another piece of paper. Sometimes, just writing it a few times (even backwards) helps you remember a verse!

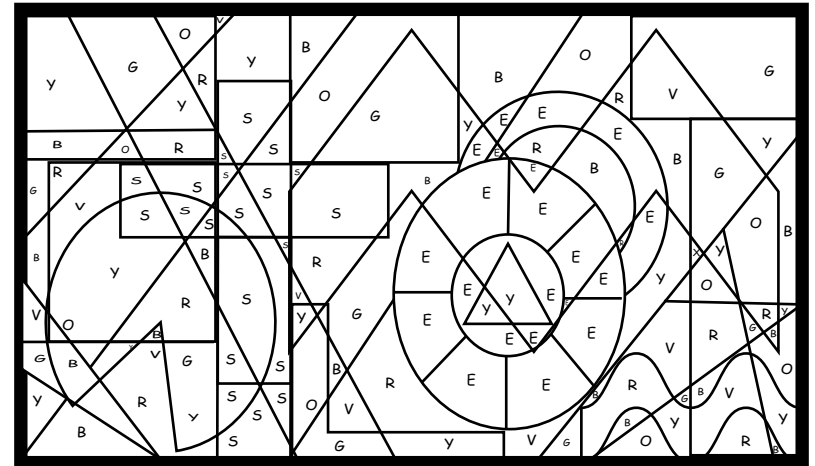

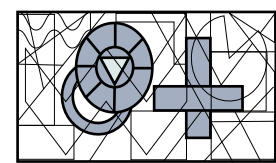
